Discussing Wisconsin's Medical Marijuana Bill

On Monday, February 22nd from 7-9pm, Room N133 of the University of Wisconsin-Waukesha will be the site of a discussion of medical marijuana legislation now before the Wisconsin State Legislature: **Assembly Bill 554/Senate Bill 368, the Jacki Rickert Medical Marijuana Act.** UW-Waukesha is located at 1500 N. University Drive Waukesha, WI. Seating is limited to 200 people, so be sure to arrive early to save a seat and check out the information tables. **Speakers include** the authors of AB554 and SB368, **State Senator Jon Erpenbach** (D-Waunakee) and **State Assembly Representative Mark Pocan** (D-Madison) plus **Is My Medicine Legal YET? (IMMLY) Founder Jacki Rickert**, namesake of the bill, with **Gary Storck of IMMLY & Wisconsin NORML.** Also included is a special performance of the song, "Legal Medicine Blues" by singer-songwriter **Rick Harris.** This is a free event, but donations to support this grassroots cause will be accepted. The doors open at 6pm, and the seminar will run from 7-9pm. At the end, the floor will be open to questions for the speakers from the audience (time permitting).
